


## What makes a place successful?

Around the world, successful public spaces have four key qualities in common:

- 1. They are accessible
- 2. People are engaged in activities there
- 3. The space is comfortable and has a good image
- 4. It is a sociable place where people meet each other and take people when they visit

## Qualities of a successful space

You can think about a space/place according to the four criteria in the orange ring. In the green ring are the number of intuitive or qualitative aspects by which to judge a place. The blue area shows the qualitative aspects that can be measured by statistics or research.
