An integrated precinct

This indicative site plan integrates landscapes, program, movement, and activity with the new music and performance venue at its core. Surrounded by the Palais Theatre to the east and a flexible pavilion to the west, this precinct will function as an active and vibrant whole.

KEY CHARACTERISTICS

- A new 5000 capacity live music and performance venue situated beside the Palais Theatre.
- A new pedestrian prioritised promenade that stitches together the surrounding landscape and builds upon current and planned upgrades to the Palais and Luna Park forecourts.
- The Jacka Boulevard pedestrian crossing relocated to the north to align with the foreshore arrival plaza.
- A vibrant music and cultural precinct that is active throughout the day, night, and year through a diversity of uses on the site, including a multipurpose pavilion which can be used as a stage.
- Consolidated loading and car parking zone in a less visible location, with 200 underground car spaces.
- The Slopes retained and preserved as important heritage landscape.
- Potential future development site to be investigated at a later stage. Interim use as an ongrade parking lot (approx. 40 spaces).
